

**THE MENDOCINO RESERVATION.**—A few weeks since, we stated that a gentleman from Russian River informed us that the Indians were leaving the Reservation, and returning to their old homes, having become dissatisfied with their new locality. Since then, we have seen and conversed with a gentleman belonging to the reservation, who assures us that our informant was mistaken; that the Indians who had returned to Russian River, had done so by the permission of the reservation officials, and that they would again return to the reservation, as soon as their permits had expired; and that although there are now upwards of 6,000 Indians at the reserve, they all appear perfectly content and happy. We sincerely trust such is a true state of affairs.
