

"The Indian Bureau has no official intelligence whatever by the last California mail, concerning our Indian relations on the Pacific, an omission on the part of the agents which occasions much disappointment, and for which the Commissioner cannot account. The agents for months past have failed to keep the bureau advised of events in that quarter."
