

REMOVAL OF INDIANS.—S. P. Storms, Sub-Indian Agent at the Nome Lackee Reservation, is at Grass Valley, for the purpose of collecting and removing to the Reservation the Indians remaining in the above locality. The *Telegraph* advises the co-operation of the citizens of the valley in securing their removal. The near approach of winter—the total annihilation of game in that vicinity—the expulsion of the fish from the rivers and the failure of the acorn crop—it is thought will compel the Indians to resort to robbery and plunder, if not sustained by charity, and that their violent extermination will be the result.
