

**INDIAN OUTRAGES IN ROUND VALLEY.—**  
We published the other day an account of Indian outrages in Mendocino county, and of the pursuit of them by the whites together with friendly Indians who overtook and killed a great many of them. The Shasta Courier, speaking of the pursuit says the whites succeeded in destroying one hundred at one camp and sixty at another. They found where the Indians had killed several whites, one of whom had been destroyed by burning at the stake! The Courier calls for rigorous treatment, and significantly remarks that "these things are not to be passed over."
