

DISPOSAL OF TROOPS.—General McDowell has ordered a Company of the Ninth U. S. Infantry, at the Presidio, to proceed to Camp Lincoln, near Crescent City, Del Norte county, to relieve the company of the Sixth Infantry, C. V., now stationed there. The latter to return at once, if practicable, to the Presidio, where they will be mustered out of service. Two companies of the same Regiment are ordered to Fort Humboldt, California, to relieve Companies A and F, of the Fourth Infantry, C. V., who will likewise immediately repair to the Presidio to be mustered out.
