The Mr. Smith, mentioned last week as having been killed by Indians, on Mattole, we learn was Seth Smith, who came from Oregon about a year since. He stopped on Bel River until about a week before he was killed. Some entrails, &c., were found in the gulch where the blood was traced, supposed to be the remains of the unfortunate man. The Indians of the rancheria where he was killed have not made their appearance yet. Indian 'Tom,' son of old 'Coon-Skin,' is supposed to have been concerned in the murder.
