

DIED.—Charles Hicks, who was shot by  
an Indian, on Bear River, while out hunt-  
ing, an account of which we published some  
weeks since, died from the effects of the  
wound, a week ago Friday.

CHASTISING THE INDIANS THAT SHOT HICKS.  
We understand that, since the death of Mr.  
Hicks, a party was raised on Eel River, and  
went out toward Bear River to chastise some  
of the scamps that so cowardly attacked and  
shot him. They came upon a band near  
Grizzly Bluff, and killed seven of them.—  
They recognized two among the number kill-  
ed, as having belonged to the ranch near  
which Hicks was wounded, and most likely  
part of the same that fell upon him at that  
time.
