

GATHERING INDIANS.—The Committee appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Humboldt county for the purpose of collecting such tame Indians as are not legally indentured, and sending them to the Government Reservations, have collected quite a number in Bucksport township. It seems however, that some obstructions and annoyances are likely to be thrown in their way by parties who have numbers of Indian servants indentured. Mr. H. P. Larabee and Mr. Fay were arrested last Thursday on a charge of false imprisonment for detaining a Squaw over night at the place they have selected as a rendezvous for all the Indians they can collect. They had some 30 or 40 Indians there, which the citizens are contributing food to support until such time as they can be removed to their proper place. They had no difficulty in giving bail to appear before next Court of Sessions, having waived any preliminary examination; wishing to have the question tested properly.
