

INDIAN BATTLE.—The settlers of Round Valley, had a battle lately about 8 miles north-west of Nome Cult farm with a band of ~~Indians and Mexicans~~ who had stolen stock from the valley. They killed about one hundred and eight Indians and two or three Spaniards. They found twenty-eight horses and a large lot of hogs.—None of the whites were injured in the fight. No Reservation Indians were engaged in the robbery.—S. F. *Mirror*.
