

BRUTAL MURDER OF AN INDIAN.—The *Courier* is informed that a most cowardly and barbarous murder was committed near North Fork of Cottonwood, in Shasta county, recently. Two white devils went to an Indian rancheria for the purpose of carrying off an Indian girl. The attempt was resisted by the mother of the girl and a crippled Indian boy, who alone were present. The villains were exasperated at the resistance of the cripple, and one of them seized him by the hair, cut his throat, and then stabbed him to the knife hilt. In the meantime the woman and girl escaped, and it is probable the perpetrators of the devilish deed will, as none but Indian testimony can be produced against them. Hanging is too good for such blood-thirsty outlaws.
