Kibbe's Indian war at the north has ended, and he has brought between five and six hundred of the Pit^{co} river and other tribes to Red Bluffs, to be placed on some one of the Indian Reservations. These Indians have been noted for years for their fighting propensities, and have caused much loss of life and property to the whites in the northern portion of the State for some years. Their power is now broken.
