Hadley, of Upper Mattole, ~~with two or three companions~~ has been engaged for some time past in getting out oak timber on Eel river near the mouth of South Fork. On the 6th inst., they were all employed in transporting the timber to the river and had left a double gun, loaded with buck shot, standing under a tree near by. An Indian on the look-out for chances, secured the gun when unobserved, and secreting himself among the rocks fired upon Mr. Hadley at a distance of but a few paces, inflicting five severe flesh wounds. After discharging both barrels the Indians—of whom there were several—hastily retreated, taking the gun with them. This is a pretty loud call for Mr. Hadley, but we are glad to learn that no danger is apprehended from his wounds.
