Verefied A freaty of Peace and Friendship, made and concluded at the Village of Temecola Californice between the rented States Indian Agent, OM Wogencraft of the one part and the Captains and Acad Men of the following Mations viz: The nation of San Louis Rey Indeans, the Rah. we as and the mile of Co. com cah rad. ATT. 1. The several Nation's above mentioned do cicknowly as the United States to be the sole and absolute Sourcigns of all the soil and territory cedere to theme by a Treaty of Peace made between them and the Republic of Mexico. Art 2. The said nations of Indeans asknowly themselves fourthy and severally under the exclusive periodection authority and protection of the Riverted States and hereby, bind themselves hereafter to repain from the commission of all acts of hostility and appreprion towards the prevenment or citizen there of, and to live on terms of peace and friendship among themselves and with all other Indean tribes which are now a may come under the protection of the United States, and furthermore bind them. selves to conform to and be foremed by the laws and regulations of the indian Aureau made and provided there for by the Compile of the United States.

Art. 3. To promote the settlement and improvement ofsaid mations it is hereby stepulated and agreed that the following District of bourtry in the State of Calefornia thall be and is hereby set apart foreour for the sole use and occupancy of the afresard mations of Indians, still reserving to the foremment of the render States all minerals found thereon . To Wit; Commencing at the South West comer of the San Jacinto Grant and renning, along the Southern and Eastern line of the same to the San Gorgones Grant, thence running along the Southern and Eastern line of the same to the northeastern comer there of there due East to the Eastern base of Siena Nevada mountain thence on a Southerly straight line in the fineral direction of the base of said mountains to a print due East of the Montheastern corner of the hast of San Jose del Valle, thence due West to said comer thence along the northeastern line of the same to the Morthwestern corner, there on a direct line to the Southeastern corner of the hant of Semecula, thence running mind the said grant, including it by West, month and East, to its Motheastern come, and from thence on a straight line to the place of beginning.
