

The bill concerning prisoners in custody under sentence of imprisonment was amended, read the third time and passed. Mr. Heydenfelt submitted a concurrent resolution which, having been amended, was adopted, providing for the final adjournment of the Legislature on the 18th inst. The act to amend an act to supersede certain courts and regulate appeals therefrom to the supreme court, was read the first and second times. The bill to fix the terms of the supreme court, holden at San Francisco, was read three several times and passed. The bill to provide for the complete organization of the counties in the State, passed the second reading, and was referred to the committee on counties and county boundaries.

In the House, the bill amendatory of a bill to organize the district courts of the State, having been amended, was read the third time and passed. The bill to take the sense of the people on the subject of the permanent location of the Capital, was amended, read the third time and passed. Mr. Crittenden, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported a bill to amend a bill to supersede certain courts, &c.; a bill regulating marriages; a bill to fix the terms of the Supreme Court at San Francisco; a joint resolution classifying the Justices of the Superior Court at the city of San Francisco; a bill to provide for the complete organization of the counties in the State, all of which were read three several times and passed, with the exception of the marriage bill, which passed the second reading. Mr. Brown reported a bill for the government and protection of Indians, which was read the first and second times. The bill concerning the compensation of members of the Legislature was considered in committee of the whole and indefinitely postponed. Mr. Baldwin introduced a bill to change the name of the towns of "Pleasant Valley" and "Steuart," which passed the second reading and was referred to a select committee. The bill authorising a loan on the faith and credit of the State, was under consideration during the entire afternoon session, and on motion was indefinitely postponed, by yeas 15, nays 9.
