

It is said that several of the
Tulari Indians living in
the number of between two hundred
and three hundred strong, and that
making incursions on the cattle and on
the Mission of Santa Buenaventura
whites in that district are alarmed,
arming themselves to resist this aggression.
A formidable coalition is supposed to exist
between the above mentioned tribe and the Santa
Buenaventura Indians. Should such be the
case, it will probably need the presence of a
military force to protect the place, as the whole
number of white males fit for service in that
place do not exceed more than forty or fifty,
and will of course be incapable of carrying on
their usual avocations for the support of their
families, and at the same time make a campaign
against their wary and treacherous foe.
