San Francisco
October 1st 1850

Sir I am in receipt of your communication
of this date requiring of me a statement of
whatsoever Government property ^{or property} for which
liabilities have been contracted by you (me)
on Government account May still remain under
your (my) control to this date,

If so, whether or no it is in form of Supplies to
Indians, and if so, whether such Supplies are still
being issued by Contractors & others,

In answer to the foregoing requirements
permit me to say that I must ascertain
probably in Person, or by the report of those
who have charge of the issuing of the Supplies
before I shall be able to make a full report
in conformity with your requirements,
for this necessary time, I ask your indulgence
