Sir: The enclosed
are slips from the two newspapers pub-
lished in Nevada County in reference to the
Council at Storms Ranch on the 6th inst.
The thirty Indians that I alluded to in a
former communication, as a delegation to
the Reservation to remain there this winter
to assist in putting in the crop and report
to their respective Tribes in the Spring, are
now on their way to that place. The oppo-
sition to the policy of removal even there,
is merely partizan and is confined
to a few only of that party.
