in charge of O. S. Wheeler (Troy Reservation)

Six Indian and twelve head of Cattle  
in charge of Maj. A. J. Peck (Susquehanna Branch)

Five Mares & ten horses in charge of Mr. P. P. P. P. P.  
(Southern Agency) with all the beef cattle  
~~and~~ ~~and~~ ~~and~~ which were placed in his charge  
by me for the Indians
