By recent advices

from Mendocino I am enabled to report every thing prosperous there. There has been sowed in small grain up to the present time, 130 acres of Rye, 240 acres of Barley & 1011 acres of oats. There is land already prepared & is intended to be sown some 250 acres in addition, making for the small grain crop 420 acres. There is also 1511 acres of land prepared for potatoes which will be planted at the proper time, It is intended also to plant 511 acres in Peas & in other vegetables. The fishery's have been successful, two thousand Salmon having been caught at the last run.

The Indians who left last fall for a visit to their old homes are returning
