I had the honor to receive certain instructions from the War Dept. in relation to certain goods designed to be distributed to the Pima and Maricopa Indians, mentioned in your letter to me of Sept. 21st 1858. I have to observe, that on the arrival of S. P. Heintzleman, Esq., Indian Agent, at this post, he assumed the charge of them, as will be seen by the paper I enclose herewith, and that when they reached this point he took possession of them. The invoices, and your letter to me of the 21st of Sept. last, were placed in his hands for his regulation.
