Sir:

I have the honor to report that I have recently visited the Indians of San Pasqual, San Gabriel, Warner's Ranch, Juncosita and San Luis Rey, in the County of San Diego, and that they are in good condition and doing well.

Upon my recommendation, Mr. Mc Duffie has sent them a shipment of plows, hoes, axes, & spades, to enable them more effectually to cultivate the lands upon which they reside, - amounting to about \$700.

I would respectfully urge upon the Department the approval of the appointment of S. J. Kendrick Esq, as Special Agent for these Indians. He has had charge of them for more than two years, during

which time he has discharged his duties with great
zeal and fidelity. No Indians in the State, have
done so well, or conducted themselves so peaceably
as these, who have received but little if any
aid from Government.

I shall submit a detailed report on
this subject by next mail.
