Lane for 1000 or 1050 dolls - for beaver furnished while making a treaty with Indians in California - also whether Riddick McKee in his report says he accepted it - - and also whether it has been paid -

I had the draft referred to in my possession received from R. L. Martin a constituent of mine to whom Lane had assigned it - and had it with a petition referred at the last Congress to the Committee on Indian Affairs who were so careful as to lose the paper - I desire to get the subject up again and need the information requested - Two or three years ago when the
