Sir. There is a certain claim amounting to ten
Thousand and sixty four dollars, { \$10,064,00⁰⁰ } the property
of Patrick Ford, of Siskiyou County of this State
which was forwarded by Hon. Riddick McKee, to the
Hon. Lake Lee, Commissioner of Indian Affairs at that time
(i.e. 1852) Now, as I have lost the copy of those papers;
I wish you to send me the originals, or certified copies
of them.

I have authorized Mr. M. Delany, to obtain
copies of them and send them on to me and I hope
you will grant him permission to do so.

the above papers comprise
first the claim, and Schedule of goods appended
thereto. 2nd, the depositions of Frank Munsdorf,
George Woods, Patrick Ford, and three
others that I now forget.

all of those depositions, (except Fords) were taken
at happy camp, Klamath County, before Thomas
J. Roach, County Judge, in October, or November 1857.
they bear no seal, as Klamath County had not
a seal at the time they were taken.
