On my arrival here on Monday last, I found your letter of April 4<sup>th</sup> awaiting me. Unfortunately we missed the Steamer, on the Isthmus of Tehuantepec, and I was obliged to remain there two weeks, which delayed my return to San Francisco that length of time.

During the next fortnight, I shall execute my official bond as Capt of Indian Affairs for this State, obtain the approval of the District Attorney, and forward the same to the Department per Steamer of June 5<sup>th</sup>. The Deposits with the U.S. Mint Treasurer, recited in yours of April 4<sup>th</sup> shall be faithfully attended to.
