Davison and 16 squaws hauling stone for
fence - Shewood at Capell
Showery and cold

Thursday 10th Tucker and 3 Indians putting
up fence Mr. Blanchan making gate
Sewell and 7 Indians cutting brush -
Davison and 3 Indians ploughing
Shewood at Capell Very rainy in the
afternoon -

Friday 11th Heavy rain all day -
D. C. Paul Indian Agent started for
San Francisco -

Saturday 12th Jewitt McBlanchan
and 15 Indians carrying rails and putting

Tuesday 15th Smith Davison and 2 Indians
ploughing (2 teams) Tucker at Kap-pa
Mr. Blanchan 20 squares and 15 Indians
putting in seed and clearing up land
Sherwood at Capell
Showery

Wednesday 16th All hands employed same
as yesterday Cloudy & warm

Thursday 17th Smith Davison Tucker &
6 Indians ploughing 3 teams -
In the afternoon Tucker repairing plough
Mr. Blanchan 20 squares and 15 Indians

6 Indians splitting rails Smith and 3
Indians hauling and laying up rails
Davison and 3 Indians getting wood
Shewood at Capell. Cloudy and warm

Thursday 24th Mr Blanchan Tucker & 6
Indians splitting & laying up rails
Smith and 2 Indians hauling straw
Davison & Shewood same as yesterday
Raining in the afternoon

Sunday 27th No work Showing -

Monday 28th Mc Blakahan 40 Squaws &
30 Indians spading up new land Ferrill
harrowing Davison Tucker and 4 Indians
ploughing (2 teams) Sherwood at Capell
fair with cool winds & heavy frost

Tuesday 29th In the forenoon heavy rain
In the afternoon Ferrill Mc Blakahan
20 Indians & 30 Squaws spading and
clearing up new land for seed. Tucker and
Davison getting out lumber for granary floor
Sherwood at Capell

Wednesday 30th Rainy all day - All the
hands getting out lumber - Sherwood
at Capell

Thursday 31st Tucker Davison & 2
Indians ploughing (2 teams) Ferrill
harrowing Mc Blakahan 30 Indians &
40 Squaws spading up new land
Sherwood at Capell
Clear cold winds & heavy frost

Friday April 1st 1859

Tucker and 3 Indians ploughing
(2 teams) Jewell harrowing Mc Blanehan
30 Indians & 4 squaws grading up new land
Davison & squaws & 4 Indians planting potatoes
Shepard & Caspell - clear with cold winds
and heavy frost

Saturday 2nd All hands same as yesterday
except Mc Blanehan and 30 squaws raking
ground and sowing carrots clear & cold
with heavy frost
