**Serious Affray—Indian Battle—Five  
Diggers Killed, &c., &c.**

PLACERVILLE, August 23.

A rencontre took place this afternoon in Georgetown between two men named Nider & Jemison, in which the latter was seriously, and it is thought dangerously wounded in the thigh by the discharge of a pistol in the hands of Nider during the fight. Nider was arrested.

Two tribes of Digger Indians—the Coloma's and the Kelsey's, had a serious fight this afternoon near American Flat. At latest advices five had been killed, several severely wounded, and the fight still progressing.
