Before Judge Baker—Friday, August 25.

Misther Michael Finnity assaulted and battered one Gin Sling, a Chinaman. Case continued.

THREE ITALIAN FISHERMEN—*Threats Against Life.*—The defendants stated that the plaintiff wished to injure the fish trade by hawking fish about the streets at reduced prices. Bound over to keep the peace in the sum of \$500 each.

CHINESE DIFFICULTIES.—Mr. Casey had been endeavoring to redress his wrongs by dressing a Chinaman. He was discharged.

Thomas Casey and John Davis, pugilistically, pugnaciously, belligerently and outrageously disorderly. Stand over for sentence.

Senor Melandrez, charged with stealing a pair of shoes. Case continued.

Valentine Ebbetts—*Grand Larceny.*—Confessed to stealing \$75; was charged with stealing \$95. Stated as his reasons for so doing, that he had been working four months and had received no wages. Sent up to Court of Sessions.

Santa Maria—*Grand Larceny.*—Stealing tobacco from the store of Rogers & Co., in Battery street. Sent up to Court of Sessions.
