I have the honor to hand you the accompanying statements of purchases made and obligations incurred by me for the Indian service, during the fiscal year ending 30th of June last, about \$4,350 - of which was for the removal and subsistence of the Indian prisoners captured in the Humboldt Indian war.

The remainder is for the pay of special agents for the yr ending 31st Decem^r last and the purchase of goods for the Reservations which will of course be paid by the respective agents for whom the purchases were made, whom funds are provided for that purpose. Many of these bills are of long standing and the holders are very anxious that payment be made at as early a day as possible.

other small bills amounting probably to \$1,000
or thereabouts, which when ready will furnish
