Hon. A. B. Greenwood,
Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

In accordance with your instructions, I have visited this Reservation for the purpose of assisting the Superintendent, Mr. McLeffie, in the performance of his official duties.

Since my arrival, I have been informed that a portion of the crop planted in the vicinity of the mill at government expense, and harvested with its teams and implements and by means of the labor and rations furnished by government, under the supervision of the Agent, has been sold for his individual benefit; and that a considerable quantity of grain now stored on the Reservation is also claimed

by him as his private property, on the ground that he purchased the land and is therefore entitled to the crop.

This reservation was surveyed in 1857, by Mr Gray, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under instructions from the late Superintendent (Mr. Newley) to Mr. Geiger the Agent, who claims a piece of ground in connection with Mr. Titus the farmer, in the vicinity of the mill. Enclosed please find copies of letters from the Register of the Land Office and the Commissioner of the General Land Office on this subject.

I have also noticed that the acres belonging to the reservation are being used in hauling timber from the mountains to the aforesaid claim of Mr. Geiger.

A copy of this letter has been furnished by me to Mr. Geiger, to enable him to make

such explanations as he may deem proper.*
