more of his tribe who deserved hanging.

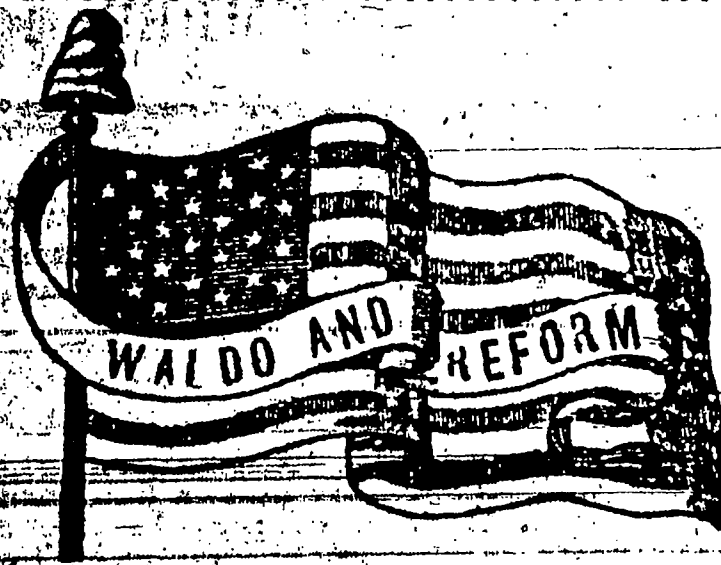
