Postscript.—Since writing the above, Mr. Worthington arrived in town and informs us that in addition to the above murders, Messrs. Proctor, Dunham, J. Smith and his partners have been killed, and Messrs. Johnson and Lamm wounded, the latter mortally, all by the Red Cap Indians at Orleans Bar. Messrs. Dunham and Proctor were at work in their claim at the time they were killed. The report of the wounding of Mr. Reynolds is incorrect.
