~~SELLING FIRE ARMS TO INDIANS.~~—We learn that miners and others on New River are selling fire arms and ammunition to the Indians in large quantities. In the absence of all law as there is in the mines, why is it that good and respectable men cannot be found who will organize themselves and take from the Indians their guns, compelling the white men who sold, to redeem them, and compel such men to leave. The distance from the Klameth to New River is less than a days journey, and the Indians of each river trade with the other, so it will be seen that the selling of fire arms to the New River Indians is equivalent to selling them to those of Klameth.
