THE INDIANS.—Capt. Judah has induced sixteen Indians of the Red Cap tribe to surrender ; killed one of Chiponish's party, captured his wife and child, two other squaws, and a large amount of grub. Among those who have come in and surrendered are two of the most influential chiefs of the party. Capt. Judah is now at the mouth of Salmon. We are informed that he keeps scouting parties out constantly and expects to capture the remainder in a week or two.
