THE BOUNTY LAND applications, under the late act of Congress, continue to pour into the Pension Office at Washington. Up to June 25th, the whole number of applications received was 177,700, of which 104,797 were enveloped and briefed, 98,844 acknowledged, 18,700 examined, 10,244 allowed, 49,600 registered, 5,803 issued, and 3,160 warrants registered.
