☞ The Employees of the Quarter Master's Department, who left Benicia with the escort to the Indian commissioners, in February last, reached this place on Wednesday the 2nd inst.

The object of the mission being completed, and the troops having returned by water from San Pedro, the train was turned over to Capt. N. Lyon, A. A. Q. Master, at this place, by Capt. E. K. Kane, Acting Quarter Master, the teamsters (some thirty in number) were discharged, and sent up to Benicia on the steamer *Ohio*, on Sunday, to get their pay. These men have been out some six months in the mountains, and have not yet received one cent of pay,—as we are informed.

Capt Kane is still here, receiving the congratulations of his numerous friends on his nomination, by the people of the Southern portion of the State, as a candidate for Governor.
