The command of Major Heintzelman arrived at this place on Sunday last—two Companies are at present stationed at the Playa and one at New Town. The Officers of this command are Major Heintzelman, Capt. D. Davidson, and Lieut. H. B. Hendershott. This command, which was ordered about a year ago to take post at the mouth of the Gila River, and in the execution of which order, more than a hundred thousand dollars has been expended, has now been compelled to return, because of the inability of the Quarter Master's Department to forward supplies, from the limited appropriations, for such purposes, by Congress.

Capt. Hardcastle having concluded his work upon the boundary line, will leave in the Steamer of the 1st proximo, for the States upon the Atlantic.
