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Some contemptible and dirty specimens of humanity has addressed us an anonymous letter, and says he is authorized to order the discontinuance of the paper now addressed to Sam. Neal, and two others which were sent to the Atlantic States by order of Mr. G. Wheeler. The letter purports to be from the last named person, but our acquaintance with that gentleman, assures us that he would not hesitate to subscribe his name to any business communication he chose to address to any person. This, together with the very trivial reason assigned, (which would admit of a thousand satisfactory explanations), induces us to pronounce the communication a contemptible humbug, and call upon Mr. Wheeler to ferret the Know-Nothing author, and properly punish his sneaking interference.

LATER FROM OREGON.—Another Indian outbreak, says the *Oregonian*, of June 16th, has commenced in Southern Oregon, between the Applegate, Illinois, and Coast Indians and the whites. The Indians have killed several white persons, and committed other depredations upon the settlers; such as shooting stock, driving mules and cattle into the mountains, &c., &c. The settlers have become alarmed, and have determined to make a treaty with these bands which will be lasting to the end of time. The Rouge River Indians have been collected together upon the reservation, by Dr. Ambrose, the Indian Agent, and were peaceable when we left, a few days ago.

The mining operations in Southern Oregon, are almost entirely suspended for the want of sufficient water. It is said that there has been less rain during the last winter and spring than ever before.

“A Savannah despatch to the *Richmond Despatch*, says, that when the sloop-of-war *Jamestown* was at Key West, the division between the guard room and the gun deck was taken down leaving the whole deck ready for action, which is not usually done except in time of war. It is argued from the fact that our relations with Spain are in a critical condition.
