The mining intelligence generally is very encouraging. On the South Fork of Scott river those working the mines are especially successful. The population of this section of the mines has greatly increased.

The troops under the command of Col. Wright had arrived at Fort Jones, and were in fine health. They were too late to participate in the Rogue River Indian War.

The health of Yreka is good, and business is reviving.
