**From Yreka.**

We were furnished, on Wednesday, with the *Mountain Herald* of the 27th ult., by Mr. Raines, of Cram, Rogers & Co.'s, and Dr. Bonnard, of Hodes & Co.'s Express.

The *Herald* says two Indian boys of the Shasta tribe, brought into Yreka two scalps, which they said had belonged to the villain Tipsey and his son. This statement is doubted, although there is no question about the scalps having graced the heads of two of the murderers of Gates, as they had in their possession some of the stolen horses and goods.

This transaction, and the promise of Bill to bring in the man who committed the recent depredations on the river, induced Lieut. Bonycastle to return to Fort Jones without chastising the Shastas.

On Wednesday of last week, the Shastas were attacked near the ferry on the Klamath, by a party of whites and the De Chute Indians which resulted in the death of the Chief Bill, and two of his warriors, and a white man by the name of Crary. The De Chute Indians, it will be recollected by our readers, came to Shasta Valley, distant four hundred miles from their home, to fight the Shastas. The De Chutes got possession of the plunder of the Shastas, and some of their squaws and children, with which they fled at once for their own country. The remainder of the Shastas, without provisions or camp equipage, have taken the war path against the whites.

The *Herald* says improvements in Yreka are rapidly progressing, New buildings are being put up with almost magic rapidity in the burnt district, which will be replaced in a few mouths by elegant brick edifices. Everything in the business line wears a go-ahead aspect.
