ties shook hands, and they left the ground.

THE PITT RIVER INDIANS, the Shasta Courier says, number 3,000, embracing all the tribes on Pitt and McCloud rivers and their tributaries. They are considered superior, physically and intellectually, to any other Indians in California, and have killed more than fifty whites, the Courier thinks, during the past three years. As their usual sources of support in the acorn crop and salmon fishing have been very short this season, they are considered to require the especial attention of the Indian Agent, in order that they may be prevented from having to steal for sustenance.
